

### **Opera Omaha's Poetry and Music Project**

**Opera Omaha** invites students in grades K-12 from Nebraska and Iowa to submit works of poetry on the theme Finding Your Voice. Selected poems will be set to music and premiered during a public concert in May 2023.

From the pool of submissions, professional composers will select poems to set to music. This is not a contest, as the composers will select poems based on what inspires them. The selected poets will have the opportunity to participate with the composer in a workshop to further develop the piece with the composer and musicians, participating in the behind-the-scenes process. The completed works will be performed in concert by local artists.

Opera Omaha's Poetry & Music Project is produced in partnership with **Nebraska Writers Collective**. Additional project partners include **The American Opera Project** and **UNO School of Music**.
