

Creative Workforce Investment Act Introduced

Nebraskans for the Arts endorses the Creative Workforce Investment Act, legislation introduced by Representatives Teresa Leger Fernández (D-NM), Jay Obernolte (R-CA) and Ted Lieu (D-CA) this past week. This bill would help invest in the creative economy through the creation of a workforce grants program to employ artists and writers to create publicly available art.

Grants for Arts Projects (Deadline Feb. 15)

Funded by the National Endowment for the Arts, Grants for Arts Projects provides funding opportunities to strengthen the nation's arts and cultural



Challenge America (Deadline April 24)

Challenge America offers support primarily to small organizations for projects that extend the reach of the arts to underserved groups/communities. Challenge



Regional Touring Program (Rolling applications)

These grants support projects that showcase the work of touring artists in M-AAA's six-state region of Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri, Nebraska, Oklahoma, and Texas. ecosystem. Grants are available for arts projects in a wide variety of artistic disciplines. Applicants may request cost share/matching grants ranging from \$10,000 to \$100,000. Designated local arts agencies eligible to subgrant may request from \$30,000 to \$150,000.

America features an abbreviated application, a robust structure of technical assistance, and matching grants of \$10,000.
